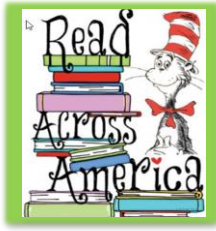

If it is not a real word, students lose a rocket ship in the upper left corner of the screen. A click of the mouse will send a bomb into unwanted debris or asteroid. Can your students become one of the top scores?

Want some help teaching your students how to form sentences? Cookie.com has this easy to use activity to learn sentence formation. Students roll the mouse over the bubble to hear the word then pop the bubbles in the correct order to create a sentence. The bubble will only pop if the correct word is chosen. The student will hear the sentence being read when it is complete. The next two or three sentences build on the first simple sentence. You can even use this on the SMARTboard. Note: if you are having trouble opening this website, try it in Internet Explorer.

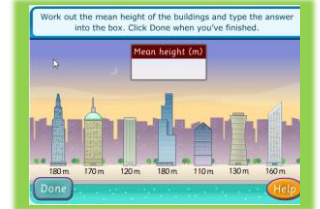

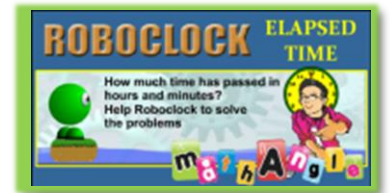

RoboClock 3 Math 1.9

Roboclock needs to cross to the other side of the water. Help him by using the stepping stones. Students look at the current clock and the clock labeled “next time.” Using the arrows in the middle of the clocks, students select how much time will pass. Once the amount of elapsed time has been selected, check the answer by clicking the “jump” button. If the answer is correct, Roboclock will land on the next stepping stone. If incorrect, Roboclock goes “poof” and the game is over. See if your students can complete all three screens and all four levels. This should make a great SMARTboard activity but heads up; there is a 10-second advertisement while the activity loads.

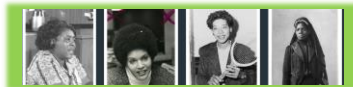
A Soft Murmur
